

Why waste it? - Answers

- Broken glass - rubbish bin (never recycle broken glass)
- Milk cartons - recycle
- Old mobile phones - recycle
- CDs and DVDs - give away
- Old wrapping paper - reuse or recycle
- Bread crusts - worm bin (they go mouldy and attract mice in the compost)
- Old newspapers - recycle or soak in water then shred and put in the compost
- Old batteries - recycle
- Banana peel - compost or worm bin
- Water bottle - recycle
- Cardboard boxes - recycle
- Paper sandwich wrap - generally it's dirty so will need to go into the rubbish
- Uneaten meat and bones - rubbish bin (they attract mice in the compost)
- Egg cartons - recycle
- Ink cartridges - recycle
- Fizzy drink bottles - recycle
- Used car oil - recycle
- Chip and chocolate wrappers - rubbish bin
- Paper printed on one side - reuse or recycle
- Old plastic wrap - rubbish bin
- Pizza boxes - if soiled they go into the rubbish bin, or you can soak and shred them and give them to the worms
- Tin cans - recycle
- Old plastic bags - reuse or recycle
- Old clothes - give away
- Old furniture - give away
- Orange peel - compost (the worms don't like citrus)
- Ice cream containers - recycle
- Old phone books - recycle
- Glass jars - recycle
- Old wood - green waste
