

CONSEQUENCE WHEEL

Consequence wheels are used to explore the consequences that can follow from actions or issues in the present.

Begin by deciding on a issue that you think is important. Place this issue in the centre of the consequence wheel. Then, explore this issue by asking the question "What are the immediate consequences?" Write these immediate consequences in the inner ring around the main issue. Link each consequence to the main idea with a single line. This indicates that they are firstorder consequences. Continue exploring second, third and forth order consequences using the outer circles.
