

HUMAN RESPIRATORY SYSTEM

Add the following labels to the human respiratory system diagram below (just add the name of the feature, not the full description):

- SINUS/NASAL CAVITY – This is the area around your nose and eyes that cleans the air that you breathe in.
- PHARYNX – This is behind the nose and mouth.
- LARYNX – This is in the neck and contains your vocal chords.
- TRACHEA – This connects the pharynx and larynx to the lungs. The trachea is responsible for the passage of air.
- BRONCHI – These are small tubes that bring air to and from the lungs.
- LUNG – This is the main part of the respiratory system. The lungs transfer oxygen to your blood-stream.
- DIAPHRAGM – This is a muscle that moves up and down to expand your lungs. The diaphragm helps you breathe!
