

TEMPLATE QUESTION SHEET

Consider the following question: *How can we help our community understand our connection to farming and agriculture?*

Develop a template for each student to create a picture of themselves with labels that describe how the things they are wearing and eating are connected to farming and agriculture.

Begin by working in your group to brainstorm your answers to the following questions using the butcher's paper your teacher gives you. Be inspired by what other people are adding to the brainstorm and add any ideas you can think of; at this stage there's no such thing as a bad idea! Once you have developed some ideas, you can work together to write your final answers in the spaces on this worksheet:

Question 1. What will your template look like? How much detail will be included? E.g. will you specify what foods or items of clothing are included?

Question 2. What will the labels look like? Will you provide spaces for these on a template or will you allow students to create their own?

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Question 3. What would you do with all the drawings? E.g. load them to a website, create an animation, or create a gallery display?

Question 4. How will you make sure that this idea helps our community understand our connection to farming and agriculture?
